- Read: 1 Corinthians 1:26-31
  - Since God calls the foolish, weak, and insignificant in the world, should Christians ever aspire to fame or political power?
  - How might achieving such things begin to lead believers toward pride?
  - Why is boasting so common in our culture? Why does God not want anyone to boast in his presence?
  - How can you better value those deemed unworthy by most? How does your church make sure such people feel welcomed?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- In what ways could you be categorized as part of the following groups: the intelligent, influential, important? How might comparing yourself against the majority of the world help you answer this question more honestly... How could this help you guard your heart against pride and other sins?
- Does someone's character always match his or her intelligence? Why or why not
  - Are you ever tempted to think that low intelligence means less holiness or that high intelligence means more holiness? Explain why.
- How should this passage influence your evangelism?
