THE BOOK OF 1 CORINTHIANS

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: What is the difference between a fan and a bandwagon fan?
 - How to become a fan, without first being a “bandwagon fan”?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday’s Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week’s message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: 1 Corinthians 2:10-3:4
 - According to this passage: What does it mean to be a “Spiritual” person?
 - How do you see the Trinity at work in this passage?
 - What words does each member of the Trinity perform?
 - Are Christians ever without the need of the Spirit to teach them the things of God?
 - Why should our past need for the Spirit to change us lead us to depend daily on the Spirit to teach us?

Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- Is it surprising to you that Paul highlights envy and strife as an indication of spiritual infancy?
- Why are these matters so dangerous to us as individuals and to the church of which we are a part?
- What reasons might Christians give to excuse strife and envy in thier midst?
- If a lost person does what comes naturally, how important is prayer for him or her?
- In what ways should the spiritual state of lost poeple drive Christians to have compassion for them?
- Why is compassion often missing from believers' interactions with unbelievers online or in person?
- MY ONE THING — What is your 1 take-a-way from this study and How will it impact your upcoming week?
