



Joyful Expectation

Begin: take this time to hear how everyone is doing, and get settled in.

- What is something to celebrate this week?
- IceBreaker: When you have something to learn, where do you turn?
 - After you've learned about it, do you tend to share and teach others?

Listen: This is for reflection on Sunday's Sermon and thoughts from the message.

- What stood out to you about this week's message?
- Is there anything you still are thinking about or have questions about?

Discover: Take time to dig deeper into the passage/topic for this week.

- Read: Psalm 25:1-10
- In Israel, lifting up one's hands was a position of making a humble request. In Vs 1 what request is being made?
- What Character traits of God do we see in this passage? List them out.
- How does seeing these traits help you to Trust God, wait for Him, and ask Him to lead you?
- In Verse 9, How might God lead us in what is right, and teach us His way?



Apply: Take time to apply these Biblical Truths to your life.

- How might we also lift up our soul to God, knowing that our lives depend completely on God?
- How can we remind ourselves of who God is on a regular basis?
 - Why should we reflect on these traits?
- In what way do you need God to lead and teach you in your walk with him now?
